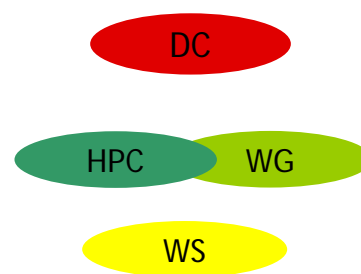

-  • **Result:** All the hype leaves CIO's & IT directors with the idea that some single event will suddenly make desktop Linux "ready"

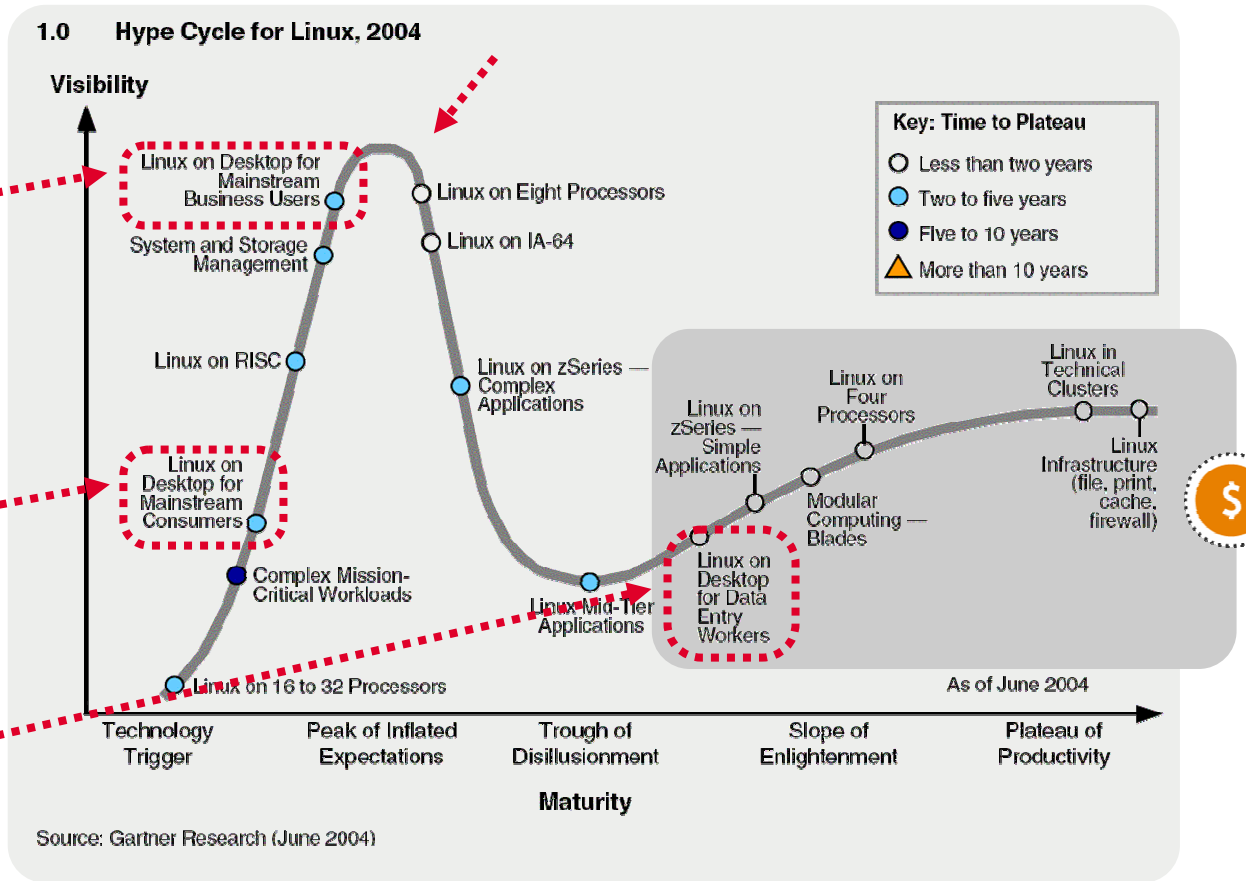

Gartner puts Linux on general use Desktops as a *high-interest* topic beset by *inflated expectations*, due for a reconciliation with reality. (Note: position was revised in late October 2004.)

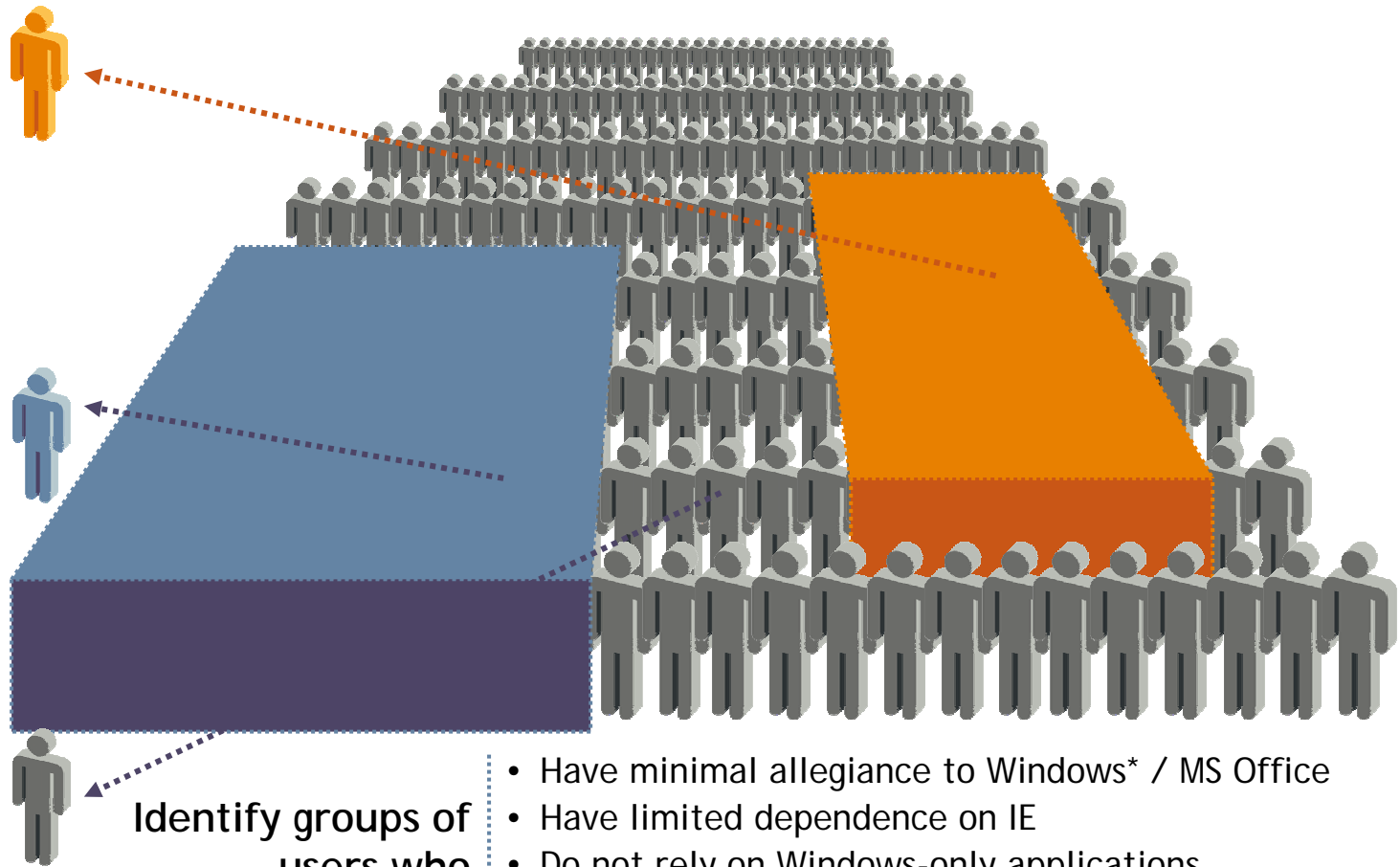
